

# Your Health and Safety: Responding to COVID-19

Greetings Blakeslee Vineyard Friends and Family,

Considering the current health concerns surrounding COVID-19, we are taking steps in keeping our guests and our team safe.

**Unfortunately, that means our St. Paddy's Day Event scheduled for this weekend, March 13 and 14, has been cancelled.**

**Reservations are now required to taste Friday - Monday.** This allows us to limit the number of visitors and practice social distancing. We ask that all guests, including Wine Club members, call to make these reservations.

Please note that reservations are not required if you are a Wine Club member who would like to pick up your latest wine allocation or make a purchase and do not plan on tasting or staying.

We are asking all guests to wash their hands upon entry and hand sanitizer is available throughout the Tasting Room for your use.

Heavily touched areas (doorknobs, faucets, etc.) are being wiped down not just before and after opening but also several times per hour with disinfectant. Tabletops are being wiped down in between each guest's use.

**If you have or had symptoms or a fever, severe cough or shortness of breath within the last 14 days or been in close contact with someone who has the virus please DO NOT make reservations.**
